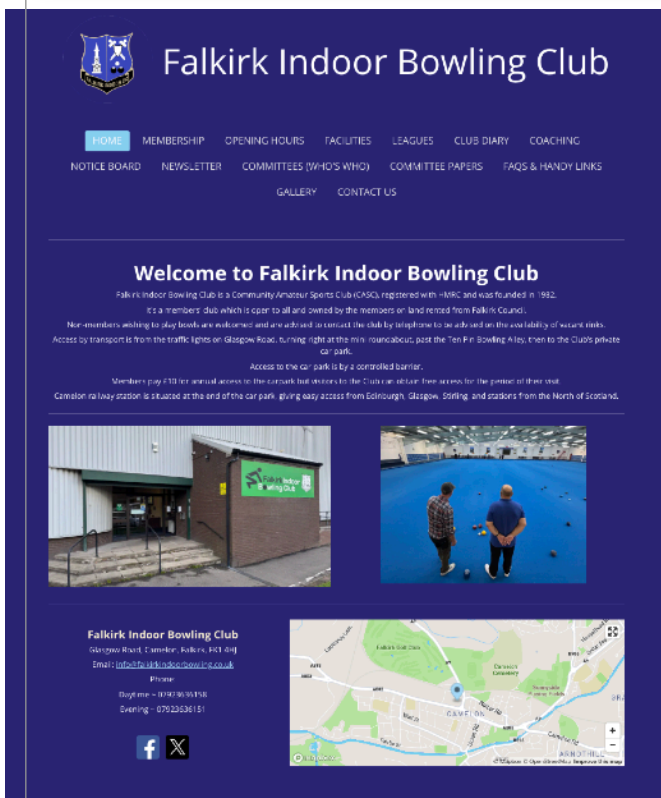

What's been going on in the Club?

February 2024 to October 2024

It's often difficult to know what's involved in the daily running of the club, but below are just some of the highlights that have been taking place over the last eight months.

- New office computers to replace old and problematic ones.
- New Club Manager System to manage subscriptions and competitions ~ BOWLR. Roll out to be developed. Old system crashing.
- Refurbished changing room following flooding. Heaters still to be installed soon.
- Replacement barrier to secure car park after a bus and a bin lorry damaged the previous one.
- Required upgrade to fob system following barrier change.
- Refurbished area in the bar for the small kitchen.
- Cellar cleared and floor sealed.
- Toilets being painted on ongoing basis.
- New insurance policy for the club renegotiated. Similar annual fee but now covering an upgraded building valuation of £3.8 million.
- New cleaners in place to take the cleaning up a level and at a considerable saving to the club.
- Negotiated power contracts for Electricity February 2025 and Gas August 2025. Unfortunately by next August there could be a rise in costs with power from £18K to £26K. Savings require to be found.

- Contract for new and more efficient Wi-Fi ongoing, at a reduced cost too.
